Capacity Grant - Literacy Alliance of the Shuswap Society**	\$10,000
Professional Development - Staff and Board – Read Family Literacy Training for staff, board governance training and Leadership Training. Training will help us to continue helping local adults to develop essential Literacy skills.	
Enderby and District Community Resource Centre**	\$10,000
Outreach Worker/Community Support Program provides direct support to families in the community, offering intense parenting support, referrals, crisis intervention, short-term counseling, and life skills. Funds seek to expand the current work arrangement with additional hours for program facilitator.

2022-2023 School Assembly Program, MADD Canada developed the School Assembly Program to teach youth in grades 7-12 new skills and information including the consequences of impaired driving, alternatives to driving impaired and to plan ahead and call 911 if they see a suspected impaired driver.
