Literacy Alliance of the Shuswap Society**	\$10,000
<p><b>Summer Literacy Program - Enderby</b> – three-week summer literacy program aimed to engage lower-income kids in a fun supportive environment, designed to promote literacy, build community, and enhance self-esteem.</p>	
A.L. Fortune Secondary School**	\$10,000
<p><b>Student Wellness Program - Community Support Program</b> provides direct support to students in the community by offering structured activities before and after school. This grant will allow properly trained staff during non-school hours allowing A.L. Fortune students to establish a culture of fitness, mental/physical health, and well-being.</p>	
North Okanagan Hospice Society	\$10,000
<p><b>Nav-CARE's - specially-trained volunteers</b> - help improve the lives of people living with serious illness by creating connections to community services and resources and providing consistent and compassionate emotional support.</p>	
MADD **	\$3,000
<p><b>2023-2024 School Assembly Program, MADD Canada</b> - Teaches youth in grades 7-12 new skills and information including the consequences of impaired driving, alternatives to driving impaired, to plan ahead and call 911 if they see a suspected impaired driver. The presentations will be at three schools in the Valley First/Enderby region including Armstrong, Enderby, and Oliver.</p>
